BACKGROUND

An entrance/drain crossing has been requested by the owner(s) of Concession NB, Lot 21 & W Pt. Lot 20 in former McGillivray Township.

At the Council Meeting on October 16, 2024, a Notice of Request for Drain Minor Improvement was approved by Council. At that same Council Meeting, R. Dobbin Engineering Inc., was appointed as Engineer to the project. Since that time, the engineer has been on the site, and it was determined that the entrance off Mount Carmel Drive does not count as a crossing on the open ditch. The entrance meets at the top of the ditch and does not completely cross the ditch, therefore the Minor Improvement request for a secondary access does not qualify under a Minor Improvement. A Notice of Request for Drain Major Improvement is required to have the requested entrance off Creamery Road.

An On-Site meeting was held January 27, 2025, and there were no further concerns or requests at that time.

The approximate location of the requested drain location is highlighted yellow in the below image:
