Capital Projects

- West Williams Electrical Upgrades
 - The work requested for Mud Creek Bluegrass Festival is completed.
- Parkhill Works Garage
 - Painting has been completed as part of the Parkhill Shop upgrade project.
- Lieury Works Garage
 - Roof restoration to take place this month.
 - Overhead door work needed has been completed.
 - Eavestrough repairs complete.

- Parkhill Community Centre Renovation
 - Currently underway.
 - Currently on time and falling within budget.
- West Williams Roof Replacement
 - Tender currently being spec'd out.
 - Expected completion mid-Fall 2025
- Boiler replacement for Arena
 - Request for quotes issued.
 - Awaiting results
 - Target date for completion: late August
- Arena stands repairs.
 - Currently having scheduling issues with contractor.
 - The completion window is currently shrinking, and staff are fearful that this will again become a rollover project due to the tight timeframe. With the contractor missing the completion window two consecutive years, Staff will reissue the work to another welding company in 2026.
- Access Control
 - Staff are working with JPW Systems building a door schedule for 2025 completion that satisfies the current department needs.
- ACRC Cooler Replacement
 - Staff have received quotes and will be notifying the vendor to procure the cooler within the month. Estimated completion/install in August.
- Automatic Floor Scrubber
 - Staff will be issuing request for quotes in August with a target of September arrival. The existing floor scrubber to be disposed of on GovDeals.
- Nairn Optimist Kitchen Range Hood
 - Project underway. Staff currently working with Middlesex Centre building department trying to get engineering approval on range hood procured.

Operational Projects

- Roof reports updated on all facilities in order to aid our asset management plan.
 - Roof leaks repaired at the HMS Insurance Centre's sloped roof.
- HVAC repairs at Shared Services Centre to improve fresh air intake.
 - Automation upgrades included as part of this repair to assist staff in operation of the system.
- Issued request for proposal for refrigeration contract for the HMS Insurance Centre and Nairn outdoor rink.

- Black and Macdonald won the contract. Staff received very competitive pricing compared to neighbouring municipalities.
- Ailsa Craig Public Works Shop had a lighting issue.
 - Utilizing an LED
- Installed public water fountain/fill station in the Shared Services Centre as a cost share with Middlesex County Library.
- Request for interest issued for North Middlesex Canteen
